From House to Home



Each year, we build and repair over **40** homes for **250** indigenous people.

In Guatemala, many indigenous families live in homes that are built with flimsy materials and lack basic necessities. Many of these families are at high risk of health issues and injury due to unsafe living conditions and poor sanitation. In the most critical cases, families are forced to live under the threat of eviction or in a home at a high risk of damage from natural disasters like landslides or tropical storms.

Mayan Families tailors home construction projects to individual families to best improve their safety, sanitation and well being. Projects include:



Constructing a complete cost-efficient home



House additions such as adding a bathroom or kitchen



Assistance navigating legal procedures and municipality requirements related to homeownership



House reparations including fixing leaky roofs or installing windows and doors



Installation of water, electricity and sewage connections
